Preparation

- 1. Any algae or mould must first be removed by mechanical means and/or with a Fungicidal Wash.
- 2. Surfaces must also be cleaned to remove any loose, friable or flaking material.

Application

- 1. The product must not be diluted, simply stir well.
- 2. Apply by brush, airless spray or roller direct from the container.
- 3. A second application may be necessary with surfaces which are particularly porous or powdery.
- 4. Allow surface to dry for up to 12 hours between coats or before decorating.

Cleaning

- 1. Clean equipment with soap and water immediately after use.
- 1. All splashes must be cleaned immediately with water containing household detergent.

Precautions in Use

Sealocrete Stabilising Solution can be applied to damp substrates. Do not apply Sealocrete Stabilising Solution when the temperature is below 5°C or when rain or frost is imminent.
